How to Apply:

1. Applicants interested in the Occupational Therapy Program, apply first to Dominican University through the Office of Graduate Admissions at duny.edu/apply.
2. Once accepted to the University, you will be assigned an advisor who will help you with the completion of your prerequisites and the process of applying to the program.
3. Applying to the Graduate Occupational Therapy Program is a separate process through the Occupational Therapy Centralized Application Service (OTCAS) at portal.otcas.org.
4. The OTCAS application process opens in mid-July and closes on rolling admission.
