The Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP) program at Dominican University New York is designed for experienced nurses who are ready for a key role in meeting the growing demand for global healthcare. It is open to nurses who have earned a Master's Degree in Nursing who are certified Family Nurse Practitioners.

Admission Information

REQUIREMENTS

- ▶ Master's degree as a Family Nurse Practitioner from an NLN or CCNE accredited program.
- ▶ Current National Certification as a Family Nurse Practitioner.
- ▶ Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA in undergraduate work and 3.5 for graduate work.
- ▶ Official transcripts from all institutions attended.
- ▶ A Curriculum Vitae.
- ▶ Three (3) letters of recommendation from former/current work supervisors. At least one must be from a professional colleague who holds a doctoral degree. Letters must be written on official letterhead and signed.
- ▶ A personal essay (1 – 2 pages) that describes your career objectives and your specific areas of clinical interest.
- ▶ A case study that represents your level of clinical expertise in providing patient care.

In addition to the admission requirements, the following are also required for entry into the Doctor of Nursing Practice program:

- ▶ An interview with the Program Coordinator.
- ▶ Relevant experience in Advanced Practice Nursing.
