# **New Charger Checklist**

#### 1. Login to Your Dominican University Email Account

- a. Now that you are a Dominican University student, we will be using your Student Email Account (Outlook) for official communication. Your Student Email Account will be used to share communications about Orientation, Financial Aid, Billing, and Registering for classes. You should begin checking your Outlook email at least once per day.
  - If you have any issues logging into your Student Email Account, you can contact itsupport@duny.edu

# 2. Send AP Scores/College Credit

- a. If you completed AP or college credit, it is your responsibility to share those with Dominican University. Schedule changes will not be made until official test scores/transcripts are received.
  - i. For AP test scores, login to your College Board account and request a Score Report
  - ii. If you earned college credit from another institution, reach out to their Registrar's Office and request an Official Transcript to be sent to Dominican University, see address below:
